Our team organized 4 community assistance programs on February 8, 9, 13 and 26 to clear areas around hand pumps at Sodlagondi, Bodalkasa, Sodlagondi and Mangezari. Unemployed youths from Mangezari participated in all programmes which were led by Mukund and Jivraj. Details of the programmes are given in the table above.

Water had spilled over while people drew from the hand pumps and had stagnated, leading to proliferation of mosquitoes and insects. Our teams cleared the area, removing scum and organic growth and dug canals to drain away the water.
